## Visit of Secretary (Minority Affairs) to Gujarat to review the progress of the Schemes

Dr. Arvind Mayaram, Secretary (Minority Affairs), Govt. of India, alongwith Mr. Badruddin Khan, Executive Director (NAWADCO), Mr. Tafseer Ahmed, Consultant (F&A NAWADCO) visited Gandhinagar (Gujarat) on July 30, 2015 for a meeting with Mr. M.S. Dagur, Additional Chief Secretary (Social Justice & Empowerment), Govt. of Gujarat, Mr. A.I. Saiyed (Rtd.I.P.S.), Chairperson (Gujarat State Waqf Board), Mr. K.G. Vanzara, Additional Secretary (Social Justice & Empowerment), Govt. of Gujarat, Mr. U.M. Bhatt, Deputy Secretary (Legal Department), Govt. of Gujarat, Mr. G.H. Khan, Chief Executive Officer (Gujarat State Waqf Board) and other Senior Officers of Social Justice Department and Gujarat State Waqf Board, to discuss various issues including implementation of the amended provisions of the Waqf Act, 1995.

While reviewing the progress of implementation of amended provisions of Waqf Act, 1995, Dr. Mayaram emphasized that extensive efforts should be made to register the cases of encroachment of Waqf Properties and dealt with accordingly, as the amended Sections of the Waqf Act, 1995 have more teeth to handle such type of cases for effective restoration of encroached Waqf Properties.

Mandate of the Waqf Boards in the light of the social & noble concept of Waqf came-up for the discussion. It was brought to the notice that Gujarat State Waqf Board is working under the Legal Department of Govt. of Gujarat. Therefore, Dr. Mayaram suggested that it should ideally be moved into the Social Justice & Empowerment Department for better functioning of Gujarat State Waqf Board as per its mandate.

During the discussion, an important issue came-up regarding the functioning of the Waqf Board from a very small office. It was brought to the notice that Waqf Board Office is in a dilapidated condition that does not even meet the basic requirements of an Office of the State Government. All present were agreed that this factor is one of the impediments in discharging the assigned functions to the Waqf Board smoothly and effectively. Dr. Mayaram suggested to the State Government Officials present in the meeting to arrange for shifting of the Board's existing Office to an appropriate accommodation.

In order to have correct inventory of the Waqf Properties in the Gujarat State, Dr. Mayaram emphasized that Waqf Properties' Survey should be started at the earliest for identification, protection & preservation of Waqf Properties. This exercise should be completed in a time-bound manner. Simultaneously, the details entered in the WAMSI System should be verified with the surveyed Waqf Properties' details and make the required corrections immediately, as the WAMSI data is already available to the public.
