Pre-Digitization Work is in progress in all the State/UT Waqf Boards where CCF Set-up is under development or completed.

Once the Pre-Digitization Work is completed in all respects then an actual Digitization Work starts. That is, all the Ownership establishing Documents are Scanned, Indexed using WAMSI –BDU Utility and finally imported into WAMSI-DMS Software at the respective SWB premises for searching and retrievals as and when required in digital formats.
