Public Interface of WAMSI On-line System launched

Hon'ble Union Minister of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India **Shri K. Rahman Khan** has launched a **Public Interface of WAMSI On-line System** on December 10, 2013 to disseminate the Waqf Property Information to the general public from a Web Portal <http://wamsi.nic.in/> on the basis of District, Sub-District, Town/Village of any State/UT with optional other parameters to narrow the search. All interested citizen will be able to know each and every thing about the Waqf Properties in their area viz., Who is managing the Waqf Property? What is the Current Status? What is the Revenue generated? What are the Welfare Activities undertaken by the Management out of the Revenue generated by the Waqf Property? Citizens can help in correcting/verifying the data shown on the Web Portal by responding with Data Verify Form available on the Web Portal itself.

Speaking at the Conference of NGO's organised by the National Minority Development and Finance Co-Operation of Union Ministry of Minority Affairs, Minister said that during the first year of 12th planning period, projects worth Rs.1109.74 crore have been approved and Rs.646.42 crore have been released for Minority Development Programmes. The total number of projects taken up under Minority Development Programme during 2012-13 include 14244 Indira Awas Yojna Houses, 2101 Additional Class Rooms, 36 Schools, 151 Hostels, 1885 Anganwadis, 14917 Drinking Water Facilities, 307 Health Centres, 793 Toilets, 41 ITIs and 13 Polytechnics, the Minister added.

The first such Conference for the Southern Region was held on Saturday, the 21st December, 2013 at the Auditorium of Delhi Public School, North Bengaluru, Karnataka. The Southern Region Conference of NGOs covered four Southern States namely, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala and Maharashtra. Conference was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Karnataka Shri Siddaramaiah and Hon'ble Union Minister of Minority Affairs, Shri K. Rahman Khan was the Chief Guest. More than 700 NGOs were participated in the Conference. Presentations, Printed Materials, Stalls of various Organizations, Open House Interactions, etc were used for creating awareness among participants.
