Knowledge transfer to conduct the GPS Survey of Waqf Properties in Lakshadweep

Introduction: Lakshadweep formerly known as the Laccadive, Minicoy, and Aminidivi Islands is a group of islands in the Laccadive Sea, 200 to 440 km off the south west coast of India. The Islands form the smallest Union Territory of India: their Total Surface Area is just 32 sq.km, Population is just 64,473 as per 2011 Census, Majority of population is following Islam Religion (Shafae School of Sunni Sect) and speaks Malayalam. Due to the geographical isolation and poor financial background of the islands the Central Government has declared the people of this area as Scheduled Tribe. **Lakshadweep State Waqf Board** was constituted first in the year 1963 and now have 343 registered Waqf Estates containing 916 Immovable Waqf Properties. Present Waqf Board is headed by Shri U.C.K. Thangal assisted by Chief Executive Officer Shri P.P. Atta deputed by GoUTL.

National WAMSI Project Coordinator Shri Naeem Ahmed, Director (Technical), NIC, New Delhi visited the Lakshadweep State Waqf Board, Kavaratti during December 20-24, 2014 to review the progress of the computerization process and to sort-out any technical problem or issue (if any) in operating the WAMSI On-line System. Another objective was to transfer the knowledge pertaining to GPS Field Survey of Waqf Properties to CCF Technical Manpower by way of sampling few Waqf Properties.

On-the-field-Training together with Knowledge Transfer with respect to GPS Field Survey & Photographs capturing of Waqf Properties & their Mutawallis, for inputting into WAMSI On-line System, will be useful to Lakshadweep State Waqf Board. This experience gained by the Technical Manpower deployed in CCF could be utilized to complete the GPS Survey of rest of the Waqf Properties of Lakshadweep Islands. As the work progresses, GIS Reporting available in WAMSI On-line System will help in decision making by the Lakshadweep State Waqf Board in identifying the encroachments (if any) on the Waqf Properties either in the past as well as in future through Historical Satellite Imageries apart from drawing layouts and finding approximate areas of the Waqf Properties.
