Union Minister of Minority Affairs **Shri K. Rahman Khan** gave the speech as a Chief Guest at the Inaugural Session of the National Conference on Protection and Management of Wakfs at Ambala (Haryana), on February 5, 2013. Some of excerpts of his speech are:

I was told that Haryana Wakf Board does not receive any budgetary grant from Central/ State Government or any other organization. Board generates its own income from wakf properties and spent for the benefit of minority community. Vigorous efforts are being made to increase its income and with increasing trend of revenue collections, the Board is marching ahead to become a vibrant and self reliant Wakf Board of the country.

I find that a session is allotted for discussion on the **Scheme of Computerization of Wakf Records** initiated by my Ministry. This scheme will have a far-reaching impact when it is completed. The digitization of the wakf records will go a long way to protect the wakf properties from encroachment and allow their development for the welfare of the community. I urge upon all present who have not completed the work of data entry, to complete the same by February 2013.
