National Monitoring Committee for Minorities

The recently constituted National Monitoring Committee for Minorities (NMCM) held its 1st meeting held on February 26, 2014. Constituted on February 12, 2014 under the chairmanship of Union Minister of Minority Affairs, NMCM includes 72 experts in minority related issues. As the Ministry has already entered in to its 9th year of establishment, need for a Monitoring Committee was being felt for long. The National Monitoring Committee is to assess the achievements and review its planning process, programmes, strategies and implementation process over a period of time.

Unauthorized Occupants Bill, 2014

Union Ministry of Minority Affairs has introduced the **Waqf Properties (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Bill, 2014** in the Rajya Sabha on February 18, 2014. It is hoped that it will be discussed in the next sitting of the Rajya Sabha.

This stand-alone legislation is introduced in the Parliament, to protect the Waqf Properties from encroachers and to treat them as deemed Public Properties since they are basically for the benefit of genuine underprivileged and needy section of the society (public cause).

It will provide a proper & perfect mechanism for protection of the Waqf Properties from encroachment, alienation and unauthorized occupation and thus, would allow for a better management of Waqf Properties. So that the income generated could be utilized for the benefit of genuine underprivileged and needy section of the society as per the intention of the Waqf.
