



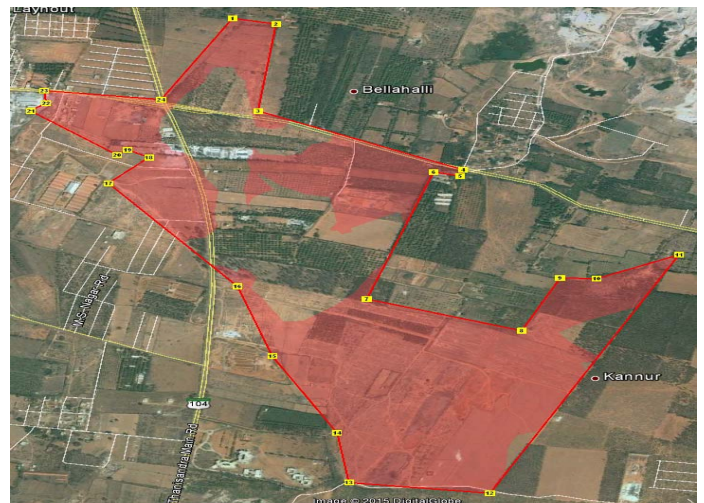
WAMSI System has helped in identifying the encroachments on Bangaluru Property

National WAMSI Project Coordinator (NPC) visited the Karnataka State Board of Auqaf, Bangaluru (KSBA) during February 11-14, 2015 to attend the issues pertaining to implementation of WAMSI Systems as per KSBA request. The basic problem found was Auqaf Register that is not being updated for decades. Consequently, the Waqf IDs pattern assigned to 24,428 Nos. of Wakf Estates (or Waqf Institution, or simply Waqf) was not in sync with the general references made by the users/stakeholders/interested parties. Moreover, attached Properties with these Auqaf are not entered as per the details available in the Files vis-à-vis the Ground Realities and their Present Status. It was decided by the Chairperson, CEO and other Senior Officers of the KSBA to first make the Auqaf Register up-to-date at the earliest and thereafter if there is new registration, it should first be entered into the Auqaf Register without any fail. Official Gazette Notifications would be the supplementary documents of the registered Auqaf. Once the Auqaf Register is up-to-date and also approved by the KSBA, WAMSI System Implementation would follow afresh immediately with the help of KSBA Staff dealing with the Subjects in various Sections in relation with the WAMSI Modules. Moreover, an IT System Manager with minimum qualification of B.Tech/BE/MCA & MBA/PGDBA (preferable) and a Data Entry Operator to assist IT System Manager, would be hired by the KSBA & deployed in the CCF, to manage the IT Infrastructure, WAMSI-DMS System and its Operations, Safe & Secured Custody of Metadata Folders, Hands-on WAMSI Systems Training to KSBA Staff from time-to-time, Technical Help & Support to KSBA Staff for WAMSI System Operations, Reporting the progress to NIC/ CWC/ MoMA/ CEO-KSBA under the close supervision of KSBA-WAMSI Nodal Officer.

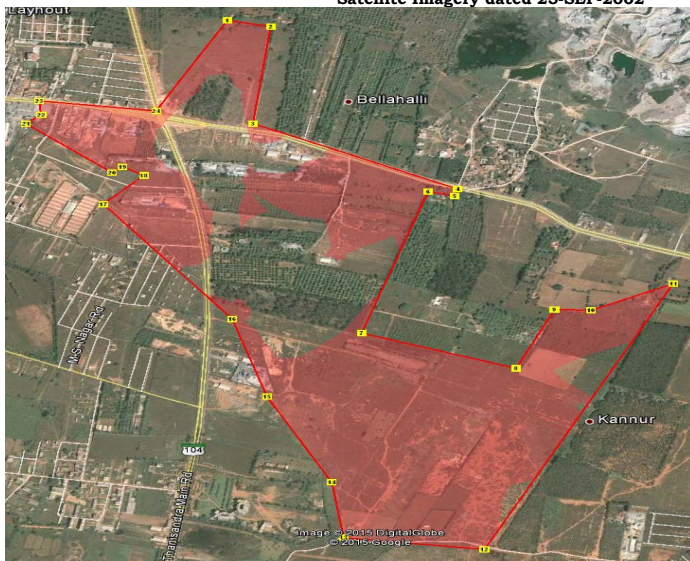
NPC also visited few Waqf Properties during the first two-days of his visit to transfer the knowledge pertaining to GPS Field Survey of Waqf Properties to the District Waqf Officers by way of sampling. This exercise act as On-the-Job-Field-Training for GPS Field Survey as well as Photographs capturing, for inputting later into the WAMSI On-line System for GIS Reporting. Interestingly, an attached Property in the Village **Bellahalli, Bangaluru vide Survey No.55 having original Area as 602.29 Acres** under the Waqf Institution "**Hazrath Manikshah Dargah**" is also visited since it is presently under the litigation at the level of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. When the GPS Coordinates were inputted into the WAMSI On-line System for this Waqf Property, the resultant GIS Report was astonishing. WAMSI GIS Reports clearly indicates the encroachments with periods when these took place through Historical Satellite Imageries. Hopefully, this vital information will help the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to refute the claims of ownerships of many encroachers on the Waqf Land. 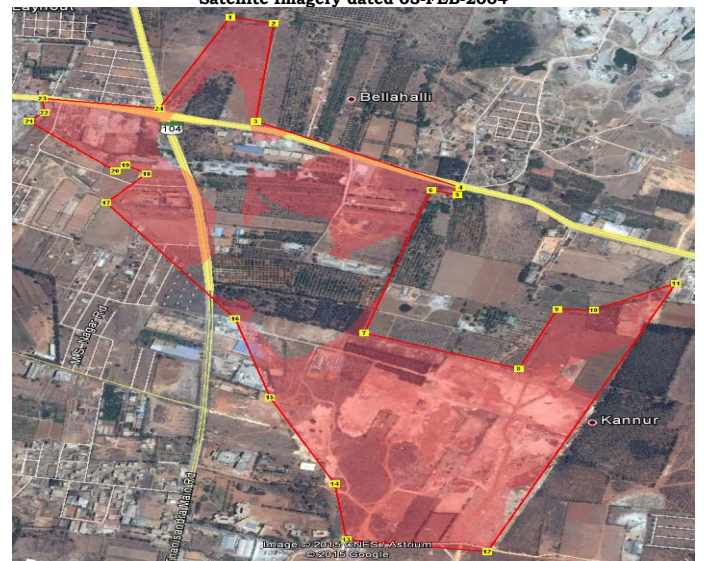
Satellite Imagery dated 25-SEP-2002
