The 7th Training Programme in the series was conducted for the staff of Uttar Pradesh Sunni Central Waqf Board on all the Modules of WAMSI On-line System from January 16 to 20, 2017 by M/s. Datapro Computer Pvt. Ltd., (an empanelled agency of NICSI) at Centralized Computing Facility (CCF) of Uttar Pradesh Sunni Central Waqf Board, 3-A Mall Avenue, LUCKNOW - 226001, Uttar Pradesh.

After introduction, the Inaugural Session of the Training Programme started by Asstt. Secretary Shri Aley Ateeq in presence of Waqf Board Staff. Ten Staff Members of Waqf Board and One Coordinator from NSIC have attended the Training Programme. The Computerization of Waqf Boards and their properties will help in ensuring transparency in the functioning of Waqf Boards.

This Conference has been organized to review the implementation of the Schemes for Strengthening of Waqf Boards and Computerization of records as well as to review the functioning of the Waqf Act, 1995.
