## On-the-Field Training to Rajasthan WB Staff on GPS Survey & Photographs Capturing

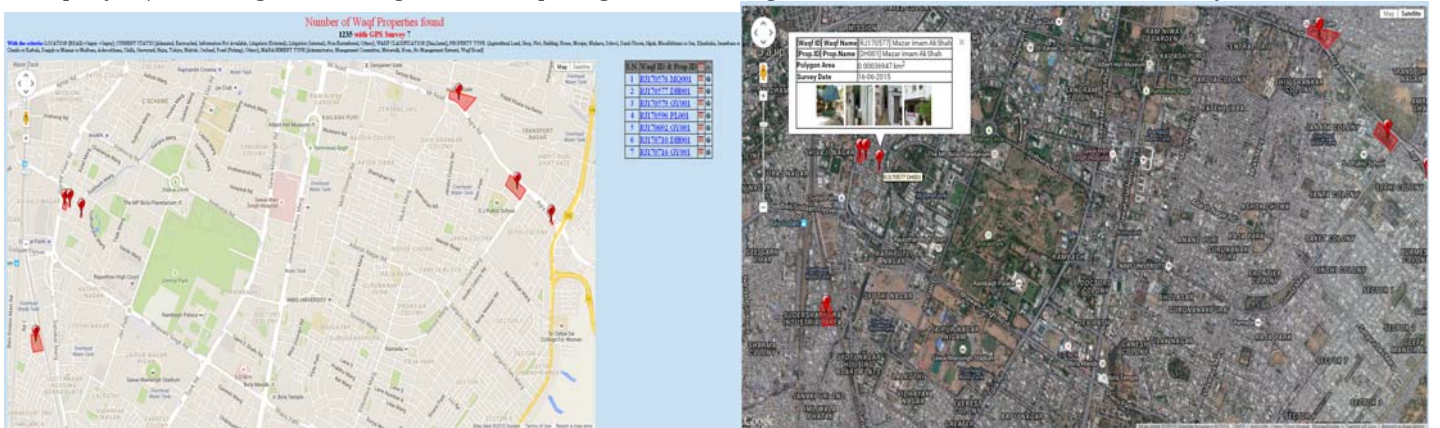
On a request of the Chief Executive Officer Rajasthan Waqf Board, National WAMSI Project Coordinator (NPC) visited Jaipur during June 16-18, 2015 to demonstrate and train the Waqf Board Staff on GPS Survey, Capturing of Property's Photographs & GPS Errors Removal and then GPS Coordinates Entry & Photographs Ingestion into the WAMSI On-line System for integrated GIS Reporting for the better management, to detect past & present encroachments (if any) and prevent future encroachments on the Waqf Properties.



GPS Survey involved the field visits to seven identified Waqf Properties on 1<sup>st</sup> day by NPC alongwith Waqf Board Staff, so they themselves operated the GPS Receiver and noted down the GPS Coordinates on "GPS Survey Form" as per "Good Practices on GPS Readings". They also captured the Property's Photographs under the supervision of NPC to get the first-hand on-the-job-training.



On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day, GPS Coordinates noted during the field visits, were corrected on "Google Earth" with the help of Waqf Board Staff who knows the geography of those areas w.r.t. Waqf Properties. Captured Photographs were also cropped to the recommended size, saved in an acceptable format with recommended naming convention using any Image Processing Software like MS-Paint or MS-Photo Editor, in accordance with "Good Practices for Property Photographs" in presence of Waqf Board Staff. Then these corrected GPS Coordinates as well as Photographs were inputted into the WAMSI On-line System against each visited Waqf Property (i.e., against each pair of Waqf ID & Property ID). Following are the Integrated GIS Reports generated through the Public Interface of WAMSI On-line System:



On the 3<sup>rd</sup> day, a live demonstration was made before the whole staff of the Waqf Board including Chairperson & Chief Executive Officer. It was a Half-day Interactive session with Questions/Answers from/to the Audience. Finally, it was decided by the Chairperson that Waqf Board will shortly undertake GPS Survey with the help of Survey Officials presently conducting the Survey of Waqf Properties. He further decided that the respective Sections of the Waqf Board will start using other Modules of WAMSI On-line System such as Annual Return, Litigation & Leasing, as per their domains. CCF Technical Staff will train & assist them in operating the WAMSI On-line System.
