## Regional Review Meeting of “Qaumi Waqf Boards Taraqqiati” Scheme held at Delhi

1<sup>st</sup> Regional Review Meeting on implementation of “Qaumi Waqf Boards Taraqqiati” Scheme and Capacity Building of Waqf Institutions was held on March 08, 2018 at New Delhi. “Qaumi Waqf Boards Taraqqiati” Scheme is an amalgamation of earlier two Schemes, which were known as “Computerization of Records of State Waqf Boards” and “Strengthening of State Waqf Boards”. Following Ten State Waqf Boards were participated: Bihar (Sunni), Bihar (Shia), Chandigarh, Delhi, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh (Sunni), Uttar Pradesh (Shia) and Uttarakhand.



The Chairpersons and Chief Executive Officers or their representatives of these Ten State/UT Waqf Boards were participated in this Regional Review Meeting to share their significant innovations and initiatives in implementing the said Scheme. Moreover, few prominent Mutawallis from each of these State/UT Waqf Boards were also invited to share their real life experiences and to seek their suggestions for successful implementation of the Scheme. Such Regional Review Meetings will also be organized in other parts of the country in the coming months.

While inaugurating 1<sup>st</sup> Regional Review Meeting **Hon'ble Union Minister of Minority Affairs, Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi** said that “**Mutawallis**” are the “**custodian**” of waqf properties. They should ensure that these properties are being utilized for betterment of the society. He further added that Waqf properties should be utilized for educational, job oriented skill development and health activities. He promised that the Central Government would award those “Mutawallis” who will perform well in the management of Waqf properties and ensures utilization of these properties for betterment of the society especially educational empowerment of girls. He informed that the focus of the Ministry of Minority Affairs this year will be on better education and employment-oriented skill development of girls.
