Training at Jharkhand State Sunni Waqf Board, Ranchi on WAMSI On-line System

4th Training Programme in the series was conducted by M/s Datapro Computers Pvt. Ltd., Surmil Complex, 2nd Floor, Singhmore Hatia, Ranchi (Jharkhand) from October 24 to 29, 2016.

In order to ensure proper training for the staff Shri Dilip Kumar Malik, IT In-charge from Central Waqf Council (CWC) attended the Inaugural Session and also spent First Two Days with the trainees. Total Six staff of the Jharkhand State Sunni Waqf Board, Ranchi attended the Training Programme with keen interest. Interestingly Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Jharkhand State Sunni Waqf Board also present on all days during the training programme. All the Modules of WAMSI On-line System were taken-up for data entry demonstration as well as practice by the participants. Moreover, GPS Field Survey and Photography of few identified Waqf properties as Hands-on-Training were also carried out during the Training Programme.

Doubts were cleared during the detailed & live demonstration of data entered by the participants. Purpose of computerization was made clear to them and consequently, they all appreciated the efforts of Government of India in the protection of the Waqf Properties and inculcating the Transparency in the working of State Waqf Boards.



Meeting of Haj Committee of India and State/UTs Haj Committees at Haj House, Mumbai for preparation of next Haj-2017



The Union Minister of State for Minority Affairs (Independent Charge) & Parliamentary Affairs, Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi addressing at the inauguration of the meeting of Haj Committee of India and States/UTs Haj Committees, in Mumbai on October 24, 2016 at Haj House to discuss various Haj related issues prelude to Haj 2017.

During inaugural speech he informed the audience that Ministry have started preparations for next Haj which include preparing a 10-15 minutes film to give necessary information to those going for Haj. He further informed that Centre is encouraging online applications for next Haj, so that people can get opportunity for Haj pilgrimage with complete transparency.

It may be pertinent to note that the work related to management of Haj pilgrimage, including administration of the Haj Committee Act, 2002 and Rules made thereunder, has been transferred from Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) to Ministry of Minority Affairs (MoMA). Ministry of Minority Affairs has taken over the work of Haj Division of MEA with effect from 1st October 2016.

Haj is one of the most complex organizational tasks undertaken by Government of India outside Indian borders. Indian pilgrims constitute the third largest national group performing the Haj. Since the year 2013 about 1,36,000 pilgrims visit Saudi Arabia every year for performing Haj. Given its complexity and geographical spread, Haj Management requires meticulous planning and close coordination with various ministries and agencies. Thus it is a yearlong managerial exercise.

Haj management involves concerted efforts of Ministry of External Affairs, Ministry of Civil Aviation, Ministry of Health, Consulate General of India, Jeddah (CGI), Haj Committee of India (HCOI) and State/UT Haj Committees. All aspects of the arrangements for the HCOI pilgrims in Saudi Arabia are coordinated by the Consulate General of India (CGI), Jeddah under the overall supervision of the Ambassador of India in Riyadh. In India, the Haj Committee of India established under the Haj Committee Act, 2002 is responsible for making the arrangements for matters connected with Haj.

With the transfer of Haj related works from MEA, Ministry of Minority Affairs will be the nodal Ministry for all matters related to Haj pilgrimage.
