Wakf (Amendment) Act, 2013

Amendments made to the Wakf (Amendment) Bill, 2010 by The Rajya Sabha, are agreed to by The Lok Sabha on September 5, 2013 and now, become Wakf (Amendment) Act, 2013 and Gazette notified by the Ministry of Law and Justice, Govt. of India on September 23, 2013 and hence, come into force immediately.

Dargah Rakh Sheikh Fatta



The Rakh Sheikh Fatta is a small village in Khadur-Sahib Tehsil in Tarn Taran District of Punjab. It is located 21 km towards East from District Headquarters Tarn Taran, 35 km from major city Amritsar and 207 km from State Capital Chandigarh. Rakh Sheikh Fatta is surrounded by Tarn Taran Tehsil towards East, Naushehra Pannuan Tehsil towards West, Rayya Tehsil towards North, Chohla Sahib Tehsil towards South.

There is a famous Dargah in Rakh Sheikh Fatta village called Dargah Sheikh Fatta which is known for *Doodh* (Milk) & *Poot* (Son). Peoples normally come here when their Cattles don't bear Child or they don't have Son. They thank Sheikh Fatta in the form of Buffalos, *Kheer*, Cash, etc., as an offering to this Dargah.

Basically, Sheikh Fatta was a *Sevak* (Servant) of Guru Arjun Dev Ji, 5th Guru of Sikh. Sheikh Fatta was born at village Talaba in Amritsar and he was very tall, strong and fair complexioned. Sheikh Fatta was a Muslim but he always worked for Guru Arjun Dev Ji.



A true incident of Sheikh Fatta:

Sheikh Fatta was very fond of *Kheer*. Once upon a time, a person was taking a bowl of *Kheer* to Guru Arjun Dev Ji. He requested for the *Kheer* but he was denied. Person said the *Kheer* is for Guruji and no one else can taste or eat before him. Shiekh Fatta was annoyed by this answer. When Guru Arjun Dev Ji came to know about this incident, he called Sheikh Fatta and said that from today onward, *Kheer* will be served to Sheikh Fatta first before anyone else and further, he said that there will so much *Kheer* coming to Sheikh Fatta that he will not be able to eat it all. From that day onward, abundance of *Kheer* and Milk is available at this place for Peoples, Animals & Birds and it is said, utensils are never emptied here.

During 1980s when the Terrorism was at its peak in Punjab, Terrorists captured the Dargah Sheikh Fatta but with the help of CRPF, it got freed and the management comes under the Punjab Wakf Board. Its Waqf ID: PBTT1723 and Prop.ID: KK0001.
