

Waqf to record marriages

New Delhi: Despite opposition from some Muslim groups, Delhi Waqf Board is planning to go ahead with its proposal to ensure registration of marriages in the community.

“It is true that few Muslim groups have opposed this proposal but we won’t step back. It will be in the benefit of Muslims and efforts will be made to evolve an agreement,” said Mufti Aijaz Arshad Qasmi, member of Delhi Waqf Board.

He said, “Due to opposition, there was no progress but now a draft will be prepared soon. Then efforts will be made to seek everybody’s approval. We will also take Delhi government’s help in this regard.” Few months back, Delhi Waqf Board decided to make arrangements for registration of marriages in Muslim community for which qazis will be deputed in all nine districts.
